Read the following Eligibility Criteria and then certify your eligibility to attempt CLEP® by signing below.

EKU Credit-by-Examination / CLEP® Eligibility

To demonstrate competence attained through educational experiences other than university instruction, students may attempt to earn College Board CLEP® credit in certain undergraduate courses. The following conditions apply to CLEP® credit by examination:

- Only admitted and active degree-seeking EKU students will be awarded credit-by-examination credits on an EKU transcript.
- Academic credit earned by external examinations shall not be considered as credit earned at EKU and will not apply toward the residency credit requirement for a degree.
- Credit earned by examination is recorded without a letter grade; hence, it has no effect upon the overall grade point average (GPA).
- College Board CLEP policy is that a student may attempt to earn credit-by-examination in a particular course only once in a three-month period.
- A student may not take a course-specific CLEP to attempt to earn credit for a course in an area in which advanced course work has already been completed.
- Special fees are assessed for CLEP credit-by-examination and must be paid prior to taking an exam. Receipt of payment must be presented before the exam is administered.
- EKU students attempting a foreign language CLEP exam at the 100-299 level in their native tongue will not have academic credit awarded by EKU.
- A valid photo I.D. must be presented before admission into any testing session.

I recognize and agree to abide by all Eastern Kentucky University regulations concerning the EKU Credit-By-Examination Program. I have read the Eligibility Criteria, and I certify that I am eligible under these rules to attempt to earn credit-by-examination in the course listed on the reverse side of this form.
